CONSTRUCTION STAGING

Roadway construction will beign in April 2019 and will move from west to east. Construction will be staged in two segments: Hennepin Ave - 5th Ave in 2019 and 5th Ave - Chicago Ave in 2020.

What to expect

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During construction, there will be an increase in traffic congestion, noise, vibration, and dust in work areas. 8th Street will be closed to through traffic during construction, but will remain open for local access. Vehicle lane, parking, and sidewalk restrictions are anticipated and will vary by block, depending on the construction activity.

Bus services on 8th Street will remain through winter 2018-2019; however, temporary bus stop closures and some route detours are anticipated. Bus services will shift to long-term detour routes in the spring of 2019 until 8th Street reconstruction work is completed.
